

Total Weekly Doses














Vaccine Equity: Age and Race/Ethnicity

Cumulative Percent Completing Vaccination Series, for 16 and Older



Vaccination Progress - Ages 12 to 15




Percent Fully Vaccinated

Cumulative Percent of 12- to 15-Year-Olds Receiving First Dose




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Vaccination Progress - Ages 16 to 17




Percent Fully Vaccinated

Cumulative Percent of 16- to 17-Year-Olds Receiving First Dose




Vaccination Progress - Ages 18 to 24




Percent Fully Vaccinated



Among American Indian Or Alaska Natives




How to read this slide:

In San Juan County, the share of vaccination for AI/AN is 33.6% higher than the 'share' (proportion) of population.


In Grant County, the share of vaccination for AI/AN is equal to the 'share' (proportion) of population.


In Guadalupe County, the share of vaccination for Al/AN is 1.1% lower than the 'share' (proportion) of population.



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



Social Vulnerability Index (SVI)


- Social Vulnerability Index: Uses
 U.S. Census Data to Determine
 Relative social Vulnerability of
 each Census tract
- Based on four related themes: socioeconomic status; household composition and disability; minority status & language; housing and transportation
- 1.0 = highest vulnerability
- 0 =Lowest vulnerability
