


% of individuals that have completed primary series by County (5+)














#### Cumulative Percent of 5- to 11-Year-Olds Receiving First Dose














#### Vaccination Progress - Ages 18 to 64


#### Cumulative Percent of 18- to 64-Year-Olds Receiving First Dose









Based on four related themes: socioeconomic status; household composition and disability; minority status & language; housing and transportation


1.0 = highest vulnerability 0 =Lowest vulnerability





(communities are geographically represented by zipcode tabulation areas ZCTAs)







#### **Vaccination Rates for Highest SVI Communities**




