



Weekly COVID-19 vaccines administered in New Mexico

























Cumulative % Receiving First Dose: Ages 16-17






Vaccination Progress - Ages 18 to 24








Percent Completing Primary Series



Vaccination Progress - Ages 40 to 64




Percent Completing Primary Series — Percent Receiving At Least One Dose — Percent Receiving First Booster







Based on four related themes: socioeconomic status; household composition and disability; minority status & language; housing and transportation


1.0 = highest vulnerability 0 =Lowest vulnerability


% Completing Primary Series Individuals (5+) by NM County



(communities are geographically represented by zipcode tabulation areas ZCTAs)





(communities are geographically represented by zipcode tabulation areas ZCTAs)





Vaccination Rates for Highest SVI Communities




