### New Mexico COVID-19 Vaccination Report June 19, 2023

Vaccination is the most powerful tool available today for preventing infection and severe illness and death due to COVID-19. In this report, we display vaccination status over time and by age, race/ethnicity, county in New Mexico.

The vaccine data comes from 2 **data sources**: NMSIIS (New Mexico Statewide Immunization Information System) and Tiberius (data from federal agency). The Tiberius collected data from federal agencies include IHS (Indian Health Service), Veterans Administration and Department of Defense. Vaccines administered includes all COVID-19 vaccinations administered from the start of the pandemic through Sunday prior to the report.

**Primary series** includes those who have completed a primary vaccination series consisting of 2 doses of the Pfizer (3-doses of Pfizer vaccine for those aged 6months-4years), Moderna or Novavax vaccine, or a single dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine. Some may have had an additional or booster vaccine as well.

**Bivalent vaccine** includes those who have received an updated Pfizer or Moderna bivalent vaccine. % received bivalent vaccine is the percentage of the New Mexico population ages 6 months and older who have received a bivalent vaccine.

On 5/12/2023, CDC updated the guideline of the COVID-19 vaccine. Everyone aged 6 years and older should get 1 updated Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine to be up to date.


People aged 65 years and older may get a 2nd dose of updated Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine.

People who are moderately or severely immunocompromised may get additional doses of updated Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine.

Children aged 6 months–5 years may need multiple doses of COVID-19 vaccine to be up to date, including at least 1 dose of updated Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine, depending on the number of doses they've previously received and their age.



#### Weekly Covid-19 Vaccines Administered (12/14/2020-6/19/2023) Total Weekly Doses




## Weekly In last 3 months(3/11/2023-6/11/2023)






# Vaccination Administered by Age(12/14/2020 --6/19/2023)



The denominator is New Mexico resident population 6-month and older.




## Vaccination Administered by Race/Ethnicity (12/14/2020 --6/19/2023)





# **NMDOH** % of individuals that have completed primary series by County (6 months+)


Statewide, 70.3% completed Primary Series.
