


New Mexico COVID-19 Cases by Date of Specimen Collection January 17, 2022


New Mexico COVID-19 Cases by Date of Specimen Collection Recent 6 Week View January 17, 2022






Average number (7-day rolling average) of cases, hospitalizations, and deaths over time





Note: Cases, hospitalizations, and deaths may not yet be reported in 7 or more days.






Metro Region Case Count by Collection Date with 7 Day Moving Average January 17, 2022


Northeast Region Case Count by Collection Date with 7 Day Moving Average January 17, 2022


Northwest Region Case Count by Collection Date with 7 Day Moving Average January 17, 2022


Southeast Region Case Count by Collection Date with 7 Day Moving Average January 17, 2022
