


New Mexico COVID-19 Cases by Date of Specimen Collection April 18, 2022


New Mexico COVID-19 Cases by Date of Specimen Collection Recent 6 Week View April 18, 2022






Average number (7-day rolling average) of cases, hospitalizations, and deaths over time





Note: Cases, hospitalizations, and deaths may not yet be reported in 7 or more days.



Daily Change in New COVID-19 Cases, by New Mexico Region, through April 11, 2022




^{*}Positive specimens collected in the last 7 or more days may not yet be reported to NMDOH. Case counts and growth acceleration during this time are underestimated.


Metro Region Case Count by Collection Date with 7 Day Moving Average April 18, 2022


Northeast Region Case Count by Collection Date with 7 Day Moving Average April 18, 2022


Northwest Region Case Count by Collection Date with 7 Day Moving Average April 18, 2022


Southeast Region Case Count by Collection Date with 7 Day Moving Average April 18, 2022
